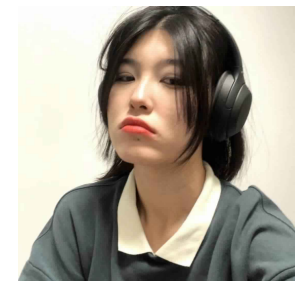
Caiyi Liu, Beijing, I have a bachelor's degree in English, and I have always had a strong interest in journalism. I have also had relevant internship experience in the field.



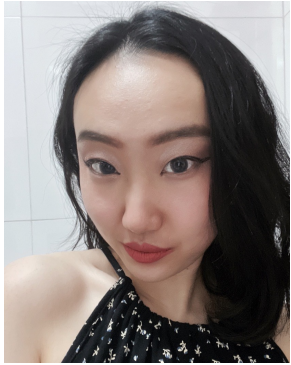
Nikita Pankaj-Singh, 22, from India. I completed my bachelor's in film, television and new media production.

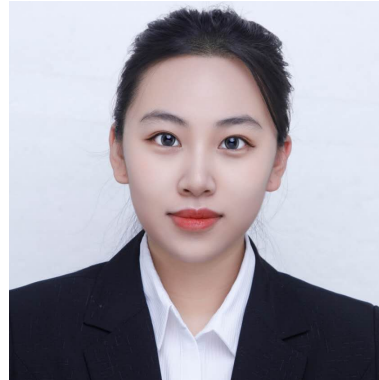

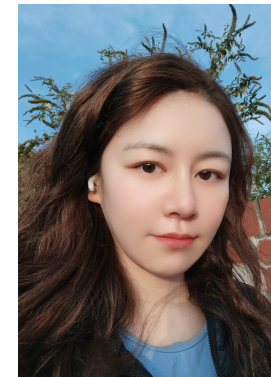
